







The glory of the wind



The preservation of the rusted and abandoned windmills, located on the Lasithi Plateau, must give environmental "breath". Their restoration was deemed sustainable and feasible by the Hellenic Mediterranean University, since the cost of repair is particularly low.

The role of the windmills will be twofold. With approximately 2,500 windmills, the villages of the Plateau will have significant benefits, since all crops will be irrigated, they will be energy self-sufficient and in addition they will supply electricity to at least 600 electric cars.

The first reconstructed windmills are already operating on the plain and are, among other things, a pole of attraction for visitors to the Lasithi Plateau
